

Air Passengers' Departure Guide

Prohibited Items List

Effective from January 1, 2014

According to the Article 44 of the **Aviation Safety and Security Act**, any person who has carried or loaded prohibited items onto aircraft will be legally punished by **imprisonment for not less than 2 years but more than 5 years.**

The list of prohibited items only applicable for airport under the jurisdiction of the Republic of Korea. When you travel to the foreign country other than Korea, please check with your airlines or travel agency whether there are additional prohibited items at your destination country.

Explosives

Hand Grenades, Dynamite, Gunpowder, Smoke Grenades, Flares, Fireworks, Mines, Plastic Explosives, Replicas of Explosives, Any Parts constituting Explosives (blasting caps, fuses, etc.), and the like



Radioactive • Infectious • Toxic Substances

Chlorine, Bleachers, Oxidizers, Mercury, Drain cleaners, Toxic Substances, Radioactive materials(including medical or commercial isotopes), Contagious or Biological Hazards. *Etc.*



Flammable Items

Matches, Lighters, Flammable Gases (e.g. butane gas), Flammable Liquids (gasoline, paints, etc.), Beverages containing 70% or More Alcohol by Volume, *Etc.*
Only one small safety match or one cigarette lighter is allowed in carry-on baggage.



Other Dangerous Items

Fire Extinguishers, Dry Ice, Tear Gas, *Etc.*
Dry ice not exceeding 2.5kg per person can be carried in aircraft by approval of the airline.

CARRY-ON



CHECKED



Spears • Swords and Knives

Paring knives, Box Cutters, Folding knives, Razor Blades, Harpoons, Throwing Stars, Darts, *Etc.*
Safety razors, razor blades in a cartridge, electric shavers are allowed in carry-on baggage.



Sporting Goods

Bats (baseball, softball, cricket), Hockey Sticks, Golf Clubs, Pool Cues, Bowling Balls, Dumbbells, Bows and Arrows, Archery, Ice Skates, and the like
Rackets, such as Tennis rackets, In-line Skates and Skateboards, Hiking sticks, Balls not inflated with air such as Baseballs are permitted in both carry-on and checked baggage.



Firearms

All Types of Firearms, Parts of Firearms, Ammunition, Stun Guns, Replicas and Imitation Firearms, Toy Guns, *Etc*

Firearms carried as checked baggage MUST be unloaded, packed in a locked hard-sided container, and declared to the airline at check-in.



Martial Arts & Self Defense Items

Nunchucks, Martial Arts Weapons, Billy Clubs, Hand Cuffs, Mace/Pepper Sprays, *Etc*
Self-defense spray carried as checked baggage MUST be one small container no more than 100ml.



Work tools

Axes, Hammers, Nail Guns, Saws, Awls and Gimlets, Drills/Screwdrivers, Drill Bits, Chisels or Scissors with pointed tips, Blades or Shafts longer than 6cm/ Wrenches, Spanners, and Pliers longer than 10cm in total length / Cattle Prods, *Etc.*

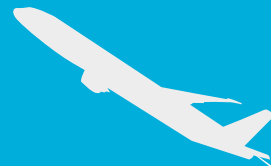

Household Items

Metal Forks, Spoons, Nail Clippers, Nail Scissors, Umbrellas, Vegetable Peelers, Bottle Openers, Corkscrews, Tweezers, Knitting and Sewing Needles, Drawing Compass, *Etc*



Medicine and/or toiletry items

Cosmetics, Hair dyes, Hair permanent kits, Bath and Shower Products, Toothpaste, Contact Lens Solutions, Calamine Lotions, Antiseptics, Internal Medicines, Skin Ointments, *Etc*.



Medical Devices & Mobility Aids

Syringe Needles, Clinical Thermometers, Portable Medical Electronic Devices (including Automated External Defibrillators: AED), Cardiac Pacemakers, Implanted Medical Electronic Devices, Canes, Crutches, Wheelchairs or Strollers, *Etc*.

Mercury thermometer MUST be carried in its protective case.

Battery-powered wheelchairs can only be carried as checked baggage.



Rescue Equipment

Small oxygen cylinder(not exceeding 5kg), a pair of cylinders included in life-jacket(allowing another pair of spare cylinders), rescue backpack for avalanche rescue(one per a person)



Batteries and portable electronic devices

Small Batteries, Watches and Clocks, Calculators, Cameras, Camcorders/Video Cameras, Cell Phones, Laptop Computers, MP3 Players, and the like

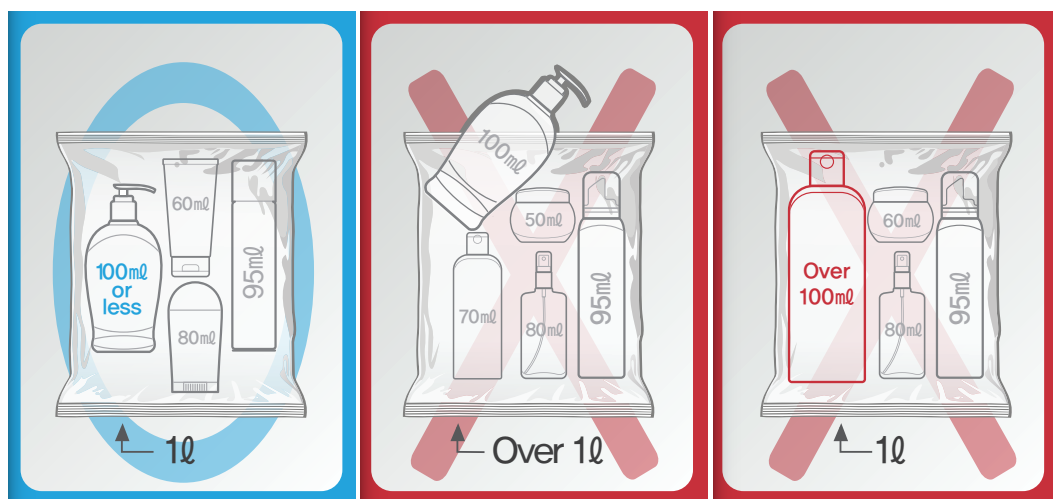

LIQUIDS, AEROSOLS AND GELS CARRY-ON RULES

Liquids, Aerosols and Gels Carry-on Rules

Liquids, aerosols, and gels(LAGs) items are strictly prohibited in carry-on baggage. Please make sure whether your liquid items meeting the following liquids, aerosols and gels carry-on Rules.



- ✓ LAGs(water, drinks, cosmetics and sprays, gels and creams, etc.) MUST be in a **container no larger than 100mℓ(3.4 oz)** and each of the items MUST be put in **ONE clear 1ℓ zip-top plastic bag.**
- ✓ **Baby food and medications to be used during the journey are allowed to exceeding 100mℓ.** For medication, please show security screener medical documentation in advance.
